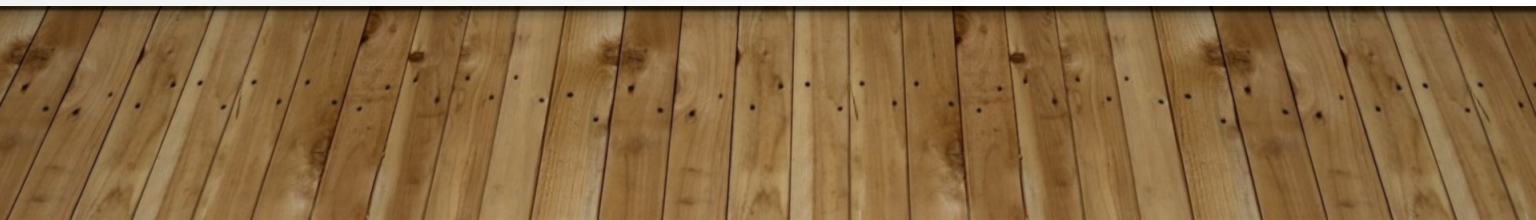




## DISAPPEARING ACT
